What the amendment does:

Makes explicit tax reform's intention to expand the Child Tax Credit.

- Creates a Deficit-Neutral Reserve Fund relating to tax cuts for working American families on the budget vehicle for tax reform.
- Allows adjustments to the budget relating to increasing per-child tax relief, which may include amending the Child Tax Credit.

How this helps:

Offers members the chance to support what should be a bipartisan element of tax reform.

- First passed by Republicans and signed into law by President Bill Clinton, and expanded with bipartisan support in the Bush tax cuts, expanding the Child Tax Credit is one of the most bipartisan proposals in the Framework.
- Voting for the amendment allows members the opportunity to show consensus support for family tax relief.
