## **A BILL**

To consider, for purposes of the Immigration and Nationality Act, that officers, officials, representatives, spokespersons, and members of Hamas, Hezbollah, Al-Qaeda, and ISIS, and individuals who endorse or espouse terrorist activities conducted by such organizations are engaged in terrorist activity.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. INCLUSION OF HAMAS, HEZBOLLAH, AL-QAEDA,**  
2 **AND ISIS OFFICIALS AND MEMBERS AMONG**  
3 **ALIENS ENGAGED IN TERRORIST ACTIVITY.**

4 Section 212(a)(3)(B)(i) of the Immigration and Na-  
5 tionality Act (8 U.S.C. 1182(a)(3)(B)) is amended, in the  
6 undesignated matter following subparagraph (IX), by  
7 striking “or spokesman of the Palestine Liberation Orga-  
8 nization” and inserting “spokesperson, or member of the  
9 Palestine Liberation Organization, Hamas, Hezbollah, Al-  
10 Qaeda, ISIS, or any successor or affiliate group, or who  
11 endorses or espouses terrorist activities conducted by any  
12 of the aforementioned groups,”.
