AMENDMENT intended to be proposed by Mr. RUBIO

Viz:

- 1 At the appropriate place, insert the following:
- 2 SEC. _____. (a) Notwithstanding any other provision
- 3 of law, beginning on the date of the enactment of this Act,
- 4 the Secretary of Homeland Security may not admit any
- 5 alien into the United States at any point along the inter-
- 6 national border (including ports of entry) unless such alien
- 7 is in possession of a valid visa authorizing such entry.
- 8 (b) The Secretary of Homeland Security may not
- 9 waive the limitation described in subsection (a).

1 (c) If the Secretary of Homeland Security determines
2 that U.S. Customs and Border Protection has full oper-
3 ational control (as defined in section 2(b) of the Secure
4 Fence Act of 2006 (Public Law 109–367; 8 U.S.C. 1701
5 note)) of the northern and southern land borders of the
6 United States, the Secretary shall submit a request to
7 Congress. If such request is approved by an Act of Con-
8 gress, the limitation described in subsection (a) shall no
9 longer have any force or effect.
