- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Suppressing Looming
- 5 Invasive Threats Harming Everglades Restoration Act" or
- 6 the "SLITHER Act".

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1	"(ii) shall be used by the Task Force
2	and agencies and entities represented on
3	the Task Force to focus cooperative and
4	collaborative efforts—
5	"(I) to guide applied research;
6	"(II) to develop innovative strate-
7	gies and tools to facilitate improved
8	management, control, or eradication
9	of listed invasive species;
10	"(III) to implement specific man-
11	agement, control, or eradication ac-
12	tivities at the appropriate periodicity
13	and intensity necessary to reduce or
14	neutralize the impacts of listed
15	invasive species, to include the use of
16	qualified skilled volunteers when ap-
17	propriate; and
18	"(IV) to develop innovative strat-
19	egies and tools to prevent future in-
20	troductions of nonnative species;";
21	(3) in subparagraph (J) (as so redesignated),
22	by striking "ecosystem" and inserting "ecosystem,
23	including the activities described in subparagraph
24	(I)"; and

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1	(4) in clause (i) of subparagraph (K) (as so re-
2	designated), by inserting ", including the priority list
3	under subparagraph (I) and the activities described
4	in that subparagraph" after "Task Force".
