## A BILL

To prohibit the importation of petroleum and petroleum products from the Russian Federation.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. PROHIBITION ON IMPORTATION OF PETRO-

4 LEUM AND PETROLEUM PRODUCTS FROM
5 THE RUSSIAN FEDERATION.

6 (a) FINDING.—Congress makes the following find-7 ings:

8 (1) Article XXI of the General Agreement on
9 Tariffs and Trade provides for security exceptions to
10 the rules of the World Trade Organization to allow

1 a member of the World Trade Organization to take 2 actions "necessary for the protection of its essential 3 security interests" during "time of war or other emergency in international relations" or "to prevent 4 5 any contracting party from taking any action in pur-6 suance of its obligations under the United Nations 7 Charter for the maintenance of international peace 8 and security".

9 (2) The aggression of the Russian Federation
10 against Ukraine warrants taking action permitted
11 under that Article.

12 (b) PROHIBITION.—The importation of petroleum13 and petroleum products from the Russian Federation is14 prohibited.

15 (c) EFFECTIVE DATE.—

16 (1) IN GENERAL.—Subject to paragraph (2),
17 the prohibition under subsection (b) applies with re18 spect to petroleum and petroleum products entered,
19 or withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, or
20 on after the date that is 15 days after the date of
21 the enactment of this Act.

(2) TRANSITION RULE.—The prohibition under
subsection (b) does not apply with respect to petroleum and petroleum products in transit to the

- 1 United States on the day before the date of the en-
- 2 actment of this Act.
